WHY: Although our Rehabilitation and Nursing Center was proactive and took an aggressive approach to secure PPE supplies to care for our residents, we do not know how long the coronavirus COVID – 19 pandemic will last. We currently have enough PPE to care for our residents and keep our staff safe, however, due to unprecedented global demand for protective equipment that was previously readily available, the timing of resupply shipments has become difficult to plan for. Our rehabilitation and nursing center is taking advantage of every opportunity to safely conserve PPE. Even with these measures, we need more supplies as soon as possible to continue to care for our residents safely and keep our staff safe.

While hospitals and other settings continue to garner much of the public's attention, nursing homes are fighting every day to ensure the highest quality of care for our most vulnerable under the most extreme conditions.

WHAT DO WE NEED?

We are asking the public to donate any of the following supplies:

- N95 masks
- Surgical or procedure masks
- Exam gloves
- Surgical gowns
- Medical face shields
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer

Full boxes of supplies are preferable, but partial boxes or individual donations are acceptable as long as the supplies are clean.
